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# Know thyself

• when we think about career we are often presented with the following picture:



• this model is bad because it assumes there is a limited choice to which you have to conform



 A better way to look at you career is to consider what you like doing, what respects your values, and drives you... and find a job where you can do that

# How to find a PhD position

 if you would like to do a PhD, the number one thing you can do to increase your chances of finding a PhD position on a topic you like is:

### PRESENT AT A CONFERENCE (OR SEVERAL OF THEM) DURING OR AFTER YOUR MASTERS

 I got all my academic positions because someone I met at a conference sent me the job announcement and I applied!

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### PRESENT AT A CONFERENCE (OR SEVERAL OF THEM) DURING OR AFTER YOUR MASTERS

- how to do this: talk to your supervisor and start writing an abstract about your MA thesis
